We are HUB-IN, an ambitious consortium of eight European cities – Angoulême, Belfast, Braşov, Genova, Lisbon, Nicosia, Slovenska Bistrica and Utrecht – along with a range of international organisations, networks and universities, linking up to create a Europe-wide ecosystem of innovation and entrepreneurship.

We are aiming to boost the regeneration of Historic Urban Areas through innovation and entrepreneurship, whilst preserving their unique cultural and social identity and the environment.

We want to:

- Maximise the potential of cultural heritage of Historic Urban Areas as a catalyst of change and avoid the risk of abandonment and neglect
- Develop new innovative and creative skills and jobs
- Create new sustainable opportunities for local traditional businesses
